The Board of Logan County Commissioners met in Special Session with Commissioners Marvin Goodman present, Monty Pearcy present and Kody Ellis present and transacted following:

The agenda was posted at 8:22 A.M. on January 26, 2022 at the Courthouse, Courthouse Annex and LoganCountyOK.com.

1. Consideration and possible action on Resolution on establishing a county-wide burn ban until Friday, February 11, 2022.

Steven Haga, Emergency Management Director, said that the county is still in severe drought conditions. He also said that 12 of 13 fire chiefs are in favor of extending the burn ban.

Monty Pearcy made the motion which was duly seconded by Kody Ellis with the voting as follows: Pearcy-AYE, Goodman-AYE and Ellis-AYE;

THAT, Resolution #22-004 establishing a burn ban in Logan County until February 11, 2022, be approved.

Commissioner Pearcy said that high line companies have been spraying trees in the right-of-way. He said he is concerned who is liable should a tree that has died after spraying tree fall.
