Emergency Meeting

The Board of Logan County Commissioners met in Emergency Session with Commissioners Monty Piarcy present and Mark Sharpton present, Zach Smith, First Deputy District #2 absent, and transacted following:

The agenda was posted at 8:05 A.M. on April 3, 2023 at the Courthouse, Courthouse Annex and LoganCountyOK.com.

Emergency meeting called to address burn ban, pursuant to 2 O.S. 16-26 B.3.

1. Meeting called to order by the Chairman.
2. Consideration and possible action on Resolution to enact a fourteen-day countywide burn ban.

Steven Haga, Emergency Management Director, said that the county is still in an extreme fire danger due to dry conditions and high wind. He said no rain is currently predicted. He said the fire that started on March 31, 2023 still has hot spots that are being monitored.

Commissioner Piarcy said he hates to interfere people with anyone but understands the extreme conditions.

Monty Piarcy made the motion which was duly seconded by Mark Sharpton with the voting as follows: Piarcy-AYE and Sharpton-AYE

THAT, Resolution #23-036 establishing a fourteen (14) day burn ban in Logan County be approved.

3. Comments, announcements, questions by the Board of County Commissioners or other county officers and department heads.

Mike Pearson, citizen, said that pets who were displaced in the fire are being taken to Paws & Claws to be housed.

4. Consideration and possible action on adjournment.

Mark Sharpton made the motion which was duly seconded by Monty Piarcy with the voting as follows: Piarcy-AYE and Sharpton-AYE;

THAT, there being no further business to come before the board the meeting was adjourned until 9:00 A.M., April 14, 2023.
