Emergency meeting called to address burn ban, pursuant to 2 O.S. 16-26 B.3.

Steven Haga, Emergency Management Director, said that the county is still in an extreme fire danger due to dry conditions and high wind. He said no rain is currently predicted.

Commissioner Pearcy said the it is starting to green in the county. He said he doesn't want to impose something unnecessarily, but understands it may still be needed.

Commissioner Sharpton said he wants to follow the law.
