SHERIFF

Sheriff Damon Devereaux presented his Estimate of Needs. He said he is asking for increased funding for personnel and jail expenses. He said that housing of federal inmates has dramatically decreased which has reduced the fees collected that support the jail. He said that efforts must be made to increase wages for staff and pay three school resource officers from General Fund. He said that providing a better wage will help in retaining staff. He stated that he would like to contract with US Fleet for GPS tracking at a cost of \$17,486.40 per year. He said that they went with a different vendor at a lower cost which has not worked out.

Sheriff Devereaux said that the increase for the jail funding is to pay for the medical and food costs of inmate.

Commissioner Goodman said the statute requires a contract with OSU for extension services, but the statute does not state the amount of the contract.

Commissioner Piearcy asked if it would interfere with payroll. Clerk Cole said that the staff is paid by OSU and the Extension Office reimburses OSU. Employees will be paid.

Commissioner Piearcy asked what would happen if no temporary appropriations were approved. Commissioner Goodman said that since nothing has been requested why should there be any appropriated at this time.

County Clerk Cole said she is frustrated at problems with the department.

Commissioner Goodman said that without an Estimate of Needs there is no contract with the county.

County Clerk Cole asked if a smaller temporary appropriation, rather than 50%, could be approved so they can continue operations. Commissioner Goodman said that OSU pays the salaries and when they aren't reimbursed, then maybe the situation will be corrected.

Commissioner Piearcy suggested approving \$10,000 total as temporary appropriations.
